COMPANY INFORMATION

Wesdome Gold Mines is in its 30th year of continuous gold mining operations in Canada. The Company is 100% Canadian focused with a pipeline of projects in various stages of development. The Eagle River Complex is located approximately 50 km south of Highway 17 and 50 km West of Wawa, Ontario. We are currently producing gold from a central mill which processes ore from the Eagle River Underground Mine and the Mishi Open Pit Mine.

Summary

- Reporting to the Mill Operations Superintendent, The Mill Senior Metallurgist is a champion of change, supporter of team work and will play a significant role in promoting the development of technical expertise and leadership.
- The Mill Metallurgist is responsible for setting the process parameters to optimize the mill recoveries and achieve environmental compliance.
- Ensuring that operations personnel run the process to the specifications that he has set and implement any changes that may be necessary are part of the Senior Metallurgist's duties.
- Notifying the Mill Maintenance General Foreman of any maintenance that is required to achieve the metallurgist's operational objectives is part of the responsibility of this position.
- Implement metallurgical directives from the Mill Superintendent.
- Relieving Mill Operations Superintendent at vacation time is a necessary part of this position.

Responsibilities / Job Duties Performed

The following list forms a basis for the position's responsibility but does not necessarily encompass all the duties that may be required in the performance of the position.

- Possess 5+ years in gold mill processing (Merrill Crowe) and/or technical diploma related to the field.
- Perform routine and urgent sampling campaigns using standard process sampling and handling practices and procedures (circuit sampling and sample preparation)
- Routine reporting (daily production and downtime reports for site distribution, month end inventory analysis, consumables, production, key performance indicators)
- Possess common core certificates for milling operations.
- Excellent computer skills, including Microsoft Office software
- Ability to work safely with good communication, interpersonal and team building skills
- Demonstrate integrity, focus, and a good work ethic.
- Working safely, responsibly and in accordance with applicable legislation, company policy, standards and procedures.
- Excellent organizational, time management and office management skills.
- Ability to work effectively as part of a team, as well as independently.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to follow procedures, prioritize issues, multi-task and document unusual results.
- Demonstrate good attendance and performance records with the ability to maintain these same standards.
- Physically capable of carrying/lifting materials, walking/climbing stairs on a daily basis
