### **COMPANY INFORMATION**

Wesdome Gold Mines has had over 30 years of continuous gold mining operations in Canada. The Company is 100% Canadian focused with a pipeline of projects in various stages of development. The Company's strategy is to build Canada's next intermediate gold producer, producing 200,000+ ounces from two mines in Ontario and Quebec. The Eagle River Complex in Wawa, Ontario is currently producing gold from two mines, the Eagle River Underground Mine and the Mishi Open pit, from a central mill. Wesdome is actively exploring its brownfields asset, the Kiena Complex in Val d'Or, Quebec. The Kiena Complex is a fully permitted former mine with a 930-metre shaft and 2,000 tonne-per-day mill. The Company trades on the Toronto Stock Exchange under the symbol "WDO".

### **SUMMARY**

Reporting to the VP Exploration in our Toronto office, the successful candidate will have two main objectives; first, to provide oversight of the Company's exploration activities, and second, to work directly with corporate development team and provide geological support and due diligence for potential property acquisition and M&A activities.

- Prioritize Company's exploration portfolio, establish and implement exploration work in coordination with local teams
- Assist in annual budgeting and press release preparation.
- Design and implement QA/QC for Company's exploration data.
- Ensure manpower, training and equipment is adequate to meet the Company's exploration goals.
- Design and manage effective exploration programs, budgets and schedules, data collection and reporting

- Generate RFPs/contracts/agreements and liaise with, and supervise, contractors and consultants as appropriate
- Management of community and government relations issues.
- Strong interpersonal and teamwork skills.
- Excellent communication and presentation skills.
