The Company's strategy is to build Canada's next intermediate gold producer, producing 200,000+ ounces from two mines in Ontario and Quebec. The Eagle River Complex in Wawa, Ontario is currently producing gold the Eagle River Underground Mine. Wesdome is actively exploring its brownfields asset, the Kiena Complex in Val d'Or, Quebec. The Kiena Complex is a fully permitted former mine with a 930-metre shaft and 2,000 tonne-per-day mill. The Company trades on the Toronto Stock Exchange under the symbol "WDO".

 - The incumbent is also responsible for oversight and compliance with all legislation and Wesdome's Health and Safety Policies and Procedures.
 - The Mill Operations Supervisor will liaise with Millwrights and Electricians to prevent unscheduled downtime and reduce downtime.
