Wesdome Gold Mines has had over 30 years of continuous gold mining operations in Canada. The Company is 100% Canadian focused with a pipeline of projects in various stages of development. The Company's strategy is to build Canada's next intermediate gold producer, producing 200,000+ ounces from two mines in Ontario and Quebec. The Eagle River Complex in Wawa, Ontario is currently producing gold the Eagle River Underground Mine. Wesdome is actively exploring its brownfields asset, the Kiena Complex in Val d'Or, Quebec. The Kiena Complex is a fully permitted former mine with a 930-metre shaft and 2,000 tonne-per-day mill. The Company trades on the Toronto Stock Exchange under the symbol "WDO".

Responsibilities / Job Duties Performed

The Resource Geologist will be responsible for creation of all grade control models.


- Update 3D lithological, structural and mineralization models for production, resources conversion and exploration purposes.
- Assist the exploration team in targeting for drilling campaigns.
- Analyse data and model parameters in line with industry best practice and Wesdome Gold Mines standards and guidelines.
- Review of reconciliation data to identify areas of model non-performance.
- Creation and delivery of all Mine Geology grade control models.
- Assist the production teams in defining targets for definition and/or delineation of the resources.
- Review monthly diamond drill QAQC issues including spatial surveys, laboratory compliance and chip sampling protocols.
- Manage data validation and assist in exploration data activities.
- Review of 3 month planned shapes to ensure all opportunities/risk are assessed and highlighted to the Engineering team.
- Exporting of all wireframes, maps and chip data and models as required for use by Technical and Exploration groups.
- Contribution to daily, weekly, and monthly meetings and reports as required.

Qualifications

- Bachelor of Science Degree in Geology or related Earth Science program.
- Must be registered as a Professional Geoscientist in the Province of Ontario (P.Geo) or be eligible for and working towards professional accreditation in Ontario.
- Experience with Datamine and Deswik software including block modelling modules.
- High attention to detail and quality control and quality assurance for all data used in estimations.
- Exposure to Geostatistics and block modelling.
- Strong computer and data management skills.
- Sound understanding of Diamond drill planning, logging and QA/QC.
- Experience using and/or interpreting various types of geological data and previous experience with mining/exploration geological software applications.
