ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Wesdome Gold Mines Ltd (“Wesdome” or the “Company”) will conduct all of its activities in a manner that ensures the protection of the environment and embraces the Company’s value of responsible mining. - To adhere to or exceed all environmental laws and regulations in effect in jurisdictions in which we conduct activities

- To reduce, reuse and recycle residual materials where possible, and to ensure the proper disposal of all waste.
- Maintains clear and robust processes and procedures for environmental incident management and reporting
- To establish an emergency environmental response plan to limit the potential impacts of an unplanned event and review this plan on an annual basis.
- To rehabilitate sites in accordance with best practise, following the laws and regulations in effect, and doing so within the required timeframe outlined in the site’s various closure plans.
- To continuously evaluate the environmental effects of our activities and identify ways in which we can improve our environmental performance.
- To build and maintain positive, trust-based working relationships with Indigenous groups, local communities, regulators and other stakeholders so that those interested in, or impacted by, our activities clearly understand our environmental management practises and performance.
